- -Half-Mile Timing will be timing, you can pick up your packets with bib numbers and timing chips under the pavilion on Friday and Saturday. You will return the timing chips back to the pavilion. Any missing chips after the event will cost you \$20 per chip and will be billed to your school. We do not want to charge you any money we just want the chips returned.

- -Results will be on http://b3rsports.com/2020-fhsaa-3a-4a-region-1/ We will have a split mat at the 2.2k and it will populate your team scores just before half way on the course. There will be a run time that is synced with the clocks at the finish, if you have your phone on the results link you will know the running time anywhere on the course.
- -To get in without paying for parking or the gate you as a coach should have been issued a FHSAA coaches' pass. Please show this to my volunteers and you will not be charged. Please let any administrators who may be coming know that they will need their FHSAA Series pass to get in without paying the gate. They will still have to pay for parking. Parking is \$10 per vehicle and the gate is \$7 per person. If you the coach do not have a FHSAA pass, then please pay the parking and we will reimburse you at packet pick up.
- We will allow athletes and teams to pick up their awards 30 minutes after the completion of their race.
- -Team tent areas: You can place your team tents anywhere in the park except near the finish line area and right beside the course.
- -We will have trainers on site located at the finish. They are there for medical emergencies only. Shin Splints are not a medical emergency! We will have ice for emergencies only again if you have a runner that needs to wrap their legs with ice then **YOUR TEAM** needs to bring a cooler with some ice.

- -Water: We will not be handing out water at the finish this year, it is the coaches job to ensure their athletes are well hydrated before the race and provide water for their athletes after the race is complete.

- (b) Regional Meet to Florida High School State Championship Series.

The first four (4) placing teams and the top four (4) placing individuals who are not members of an advancing team shall advance to the Florida High School State Championship Meet. A runner who qualifies as a member of a qualifying team may be replaced in the team lineup [regional meet/Florida High School State Championship Series] by a substitute. The substitute, however, shall not be eligible for individual honors on any subsequent level of competition.

4.5.2.3.1 Teams. A team shall be composed of five (5) to ten (10) runners during the district round and five (5) to seven (7) runners during succeeding rounds. Schools that enter fewer than five (5) runners, and schools from which fewer than five (5) runners finish the race, at any Florida High School State Championship Series meet shall not be eligible for team honors. Individual contestants from such schools, however, may earn individual awards.
