## **Race Format**

World 100 has its own special format.

### **Seeding Qualifier**

- We will set a count down timer for 10 minutes racers can get their 10-laps in any time in those 10 minutes. Fastest lap will determine your race and line up for the heat races.**

## Heat Races

- Based on your qualifying time, you will be grouped into heat races consisting of 6 cars.
- Heat races are 20 laps in length
- Depending on number of cars will depend on how many heat races per class.
- If there are 12 cars, then we will split the field into two races. The odd number qualifiers (1,3,5,7,9,11) will race the first race. The even number qualifiers (2,4,6,8,10,12) will race in the second race.
- Top 3 finishers in each race will make it to the A main.
- The rest of the cars will run in the B Main with the B main running before the A main.

## Main Events

- Main events will have 6 cars qualifying in from their top 3 finish in the heat race. The last two spots will be filled by the top 2 coming out of the B-Main.
- The lowest main event will run first
- Laps for main events are as follows:
  - A-Main – 50 Laps
  - B-Main – 30 Laps
  - C-Main – 20 Laps
  - D-Main and Lower – 20 Laps
  - Top Finisher from each main event will bump to the back of the next higher main event. Top 2 from the B-Main will make it into the A-Main.

### **Awards**

#### Weekly

- Each racer will receive a plaque for each class they run in with the race dates on them. Each race date you will receive a sticker with your place to put on the plaque for the entire season. The end of the year the top 2 per class will receive a points series trophy.

#### Series

- Each racer will receive a new set of tires and new battery.
