-Half-Mile Timing will be timing, you can pick up your packets with bib numbers and timing chips under the pavilion. You will return the timing chips back to the pavilion after the event. -For any timing issues please find Ron or Tommie. Have your discrepancy written down so they can hand it to the timer. Once the timer has evaluated the discrepancy Tommie or Ron will let you know the outcome.

-Advancement Regions to State; top 8 teams and top 4 individuals not on a team will advance on. FHSAA Rule 4.5.2.2.4 (b)

4.5.2.3.1 Teams. A team shall be composed of five (5) to ten (10) runners during the district round and five (5) to seven (7) runners during succeeding rounds. Schools that enter fewer than five (5) runners, and schools from which fewer than

five (5) runners finish the race, at any Florida High School State Championship Series meet shall not be eligible for team honors. Individual contestants from such schools, however, may earn individual awards.
